Dubai-based Range Developments has started work on its new Park Hyatt hotel and resort project, a move which will create around 350 new jobs on the Caribbean island.

When completed, the Park Hyatt St Kitts, which was first announced in July 2012, will be a major highlight of Christophe Harbour, a 2,500 acre resort community on the island's southeast peninsula.

The development will feature 200 rooms and up to 43 branded residential villas and apartments across three phases.

Mohammed Asaria is vice president of Dubai-based Range Developments told the Associated Press news agency construction of the first phase will create around 350 new jobs on the island.




